CITY OF LOS ANGELES TAX AMNESTY PROGRAM

Dear Interested Party:

This letter is to inform you that from September 1 through December 2, 2013 businesses with unpaid taxes or under reported gross receipts or those who have not registered with the Office of Finance can benefit from the City of Los Angeles Tax Amnesty Program.

The program provides an opportunity for businesses to pay delinquent City taxes and avoid up to forty percent in penalties. The following City taxes qualify for amnesty: Business Tax, Telephone, Electricity & Gas Users Taxes, Commercial Tenant's Occupancy Tax, Transient Occupancy Tax, and Parking Occupancy Tax. Following this amnesty period, the Office of Finance will vigorously pursue a range of enforcement actions such as possible legal action and publication of tax debt.

As part of a comprehensive outreach campaign, we have sent you this notification and copies of our flyer and brochure for distribution, which describes the Tax Amnesty Program in multiple languages. We have other outreach programs in process such as advertising through radio and print media.

In this effort we would greatly appreciate it if you would help in promoting this program by notifying businesses that might benefit from tax amnesty. If possible, please post the brochure and/or flyer on your website or at your workplace location.
